Thanks to Sue Smith (and Mike for being gardening helpers after Christmas – what a difference they made!

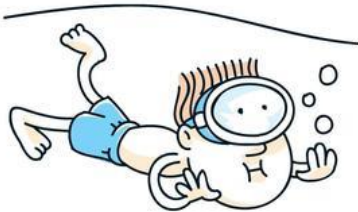
Welcome to Mrs Cuffe-Soan (Marie) who is returning to teaching and is spending some time working with us.
