Places available with an immediate start!

Our Nursery is a safe and exciting place where children learn, develop, have fun and are nurtured and cared for. We have a large outdoor area and children can access this at any time. Both our outdoor and indoor areas are carefully resourced to engage children and promote development of key skills.

Our embedded nursery is available 8:45-3:15 week days, with wrap around care available. If you are eligible for 30 hours of free provision, you will need an eligibility code. Applications need to be done via:

www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

To claim for the 30hrs you must apply the term before you intend your child to attend nursery.

Your eligibility depends on:

- if you are working
- your income
- your child's age and circumstances
- your immigration status.

If you are working, you can usually get 30 hours free childcare if you are:

- in work
- on sick leave or annual leave on shared parental, maternity, paternity or adoption leave

If you are not currently working you may still be eligible if your partner is working, and you get Incapacity Benefit, Severe Disablement Allowance, Carer's Allowance or contribution-based Employment and Support Allowance. You can apply if you're starting or restarting work within the next 31 days.

1 September to 31 December
 1 January to 31 March
 1 April to 31 August

When they can get 30 hours from

Term starting on or after 1 January
 Term starting on or after 1 April
 Term starting on or after 1 September

Recommended time to apply

15 October to 30 November
 15 January to 28 February
 15 June to 31 July

Additional information and pricing

Please note: Sessions are free to children entitled to 30 hours and not claiming for this hour at another setting.

Morning session - 9.00 to 12.00pm

Children aged 3 but not yet entitled to funding may access this session at a cost of £12.00.

Lunch session - 12.00 to 1.00pm

£4.00 for children entitled to 15 hours OR entitled to 30 hours but claiming elsewhere.

All children staying in school are able to bring a packed lunch or order a school dinner through our online ordering system – Parent Pay. The cost of a school dinner is £2.60 per day.

Afternoon session – 1.00 – 3.15pm

All children staying for the afternoon but not yet entitled to funding may access this session at a cost of £8.00.

An entitlement of 30 hours per week can be spread between more than one provider and across the year. Parents fulfilling the criteria to receive up to 30 hours funded nursery education will be required to apply for an Eligibility Code at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. If you wish to access more than 15 hours per week, your code must be submitted with your application, along with your National Insurance numbers, in order for us to verify your entitlement – please see additional sheet for further information.

Attendance in nursery education at Culgaith CE School does not guarantee a place in Reception in the September following your child's 4th birthday. The Local Authority deals with admissions into Reception and nursery attendance is not a factor used in allocating places. Applications for a Reception place would still need to be made in line with the Local Authority procedures. Please complete form SA13 – Applying for a Nursery Place which you can find on the Cumbria County Council Website or please ask in the school office. The SA13 may be submitted to the Local Authority should the number of applications exceed the number of places available.
